Kolb Grading was awarded a contract for expanding the Louis Armstrong International Airport in New Orleans, Louisiana. The scope of work included:

- Stabilizing the Cypress Swamp for expansion
- Excavate and dispose of over 200,000 cy of unsuitable materials
- Remove storm, sanitary, water, electrical, and streets
- Import over 1,760,000 cy of sand for stabilization and surcharge
- Managed over 100 hired trucks importing 30,000 cy per day
- Milled asphalt and crushed contract to build temp access roads
- 14,000,000 If of wick drain installation for settlement
